

Jerusalem Elsewhere: The German Recensions

A Mobile symposium

Germany, October 21-28, 2011

(Görlitz, Eichstätt, Nürnberg, Fulda, Wienhausen, Hamburg)

Jointly sponsored by the Max Planck Society (Minerva-Gentner Symposium 2011) and the project 'Spectrum Visual Translations of Jerusalem' organized by the European Forum at the Hebrew University

Following the 'Visual Constructs of Jerusalem' conference held in Jerusalem in November 2010, that provided the broader historical and theoretical framework, the October 2011 mobile symposium will focus on Germany as a case study to fine-tune conclusions and ground them in the various categories of Jerusalem's translations. The 2011 symposium will comprise background, theoretical and historical sessions as well as discussions held at the sites included in the mobile symposium, which are, or display, Jerusalem representations, each taken as representative of a range of other European references to Jerusalem.

The sessions held *in situ* will focus on the place itself and on specific comparisons aimed at broadening the scope of the specific place, while the conference sessions will attempt to draw on the significance of German representations (those included and those not included in the trip) for the phenomenon of Jerusalem translations in general.

The participants in the symposium are graduate students from Israel and Germany as well as a few invited scholars.
